ICT Proposers' Day is an information fair with no formal agenda. However, there will be:

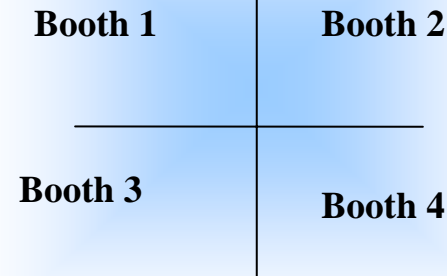
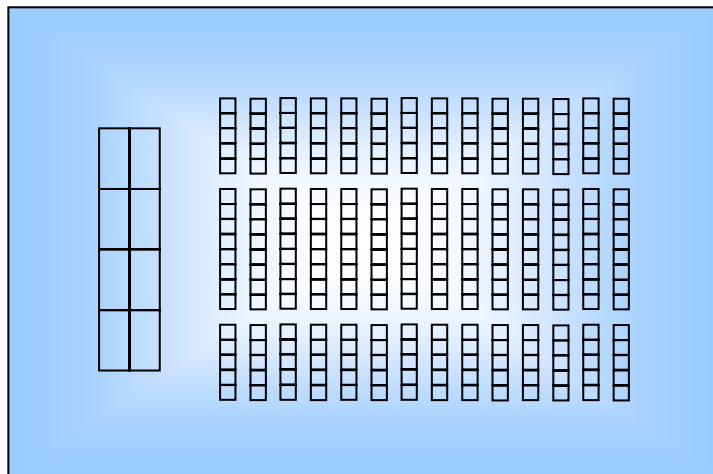
- 'Presentation rooms': 8 scenes dedicated to:

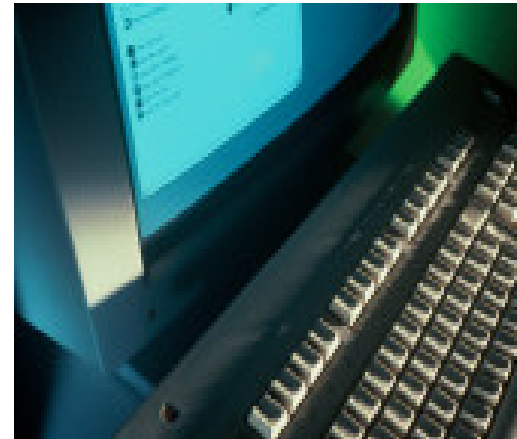
